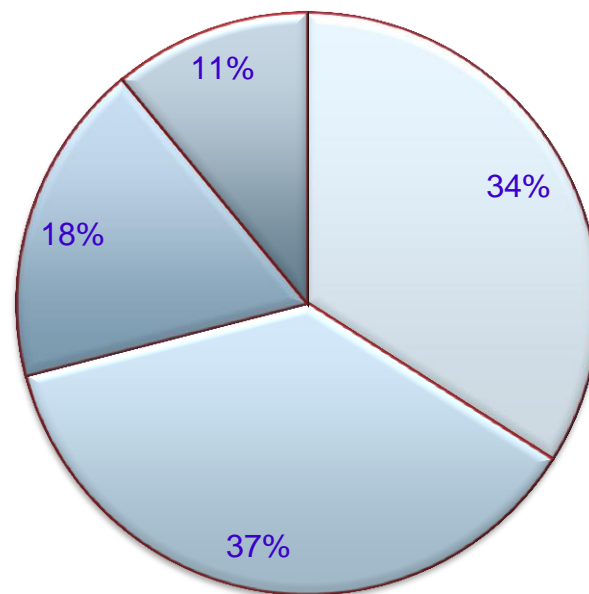
Careers Registration

 - UK/ EU / international

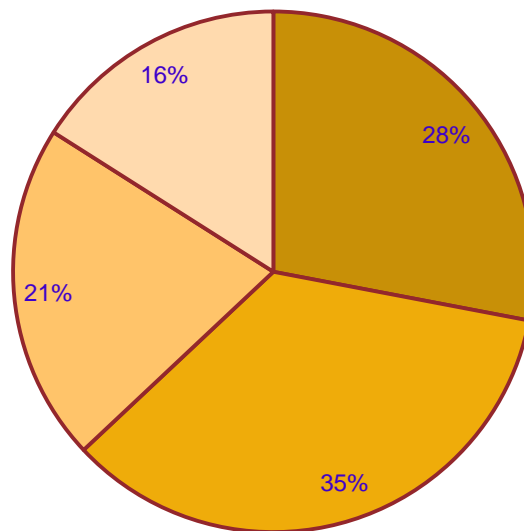

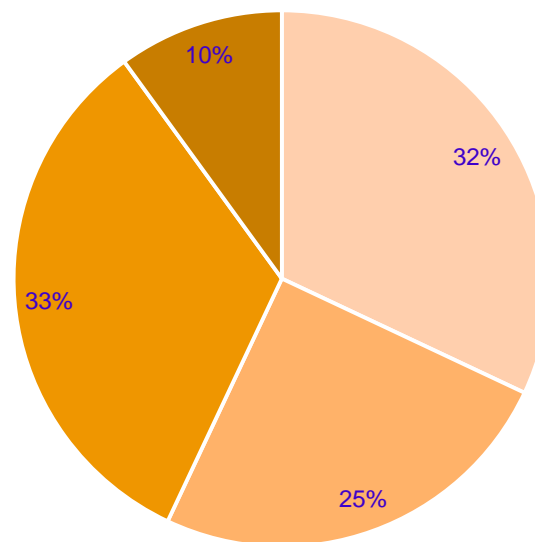
