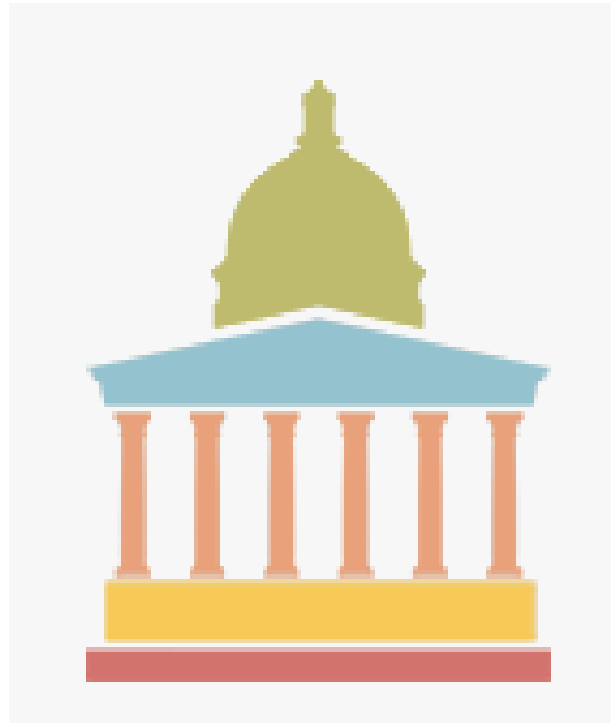

# The UCL Connected Curriculum

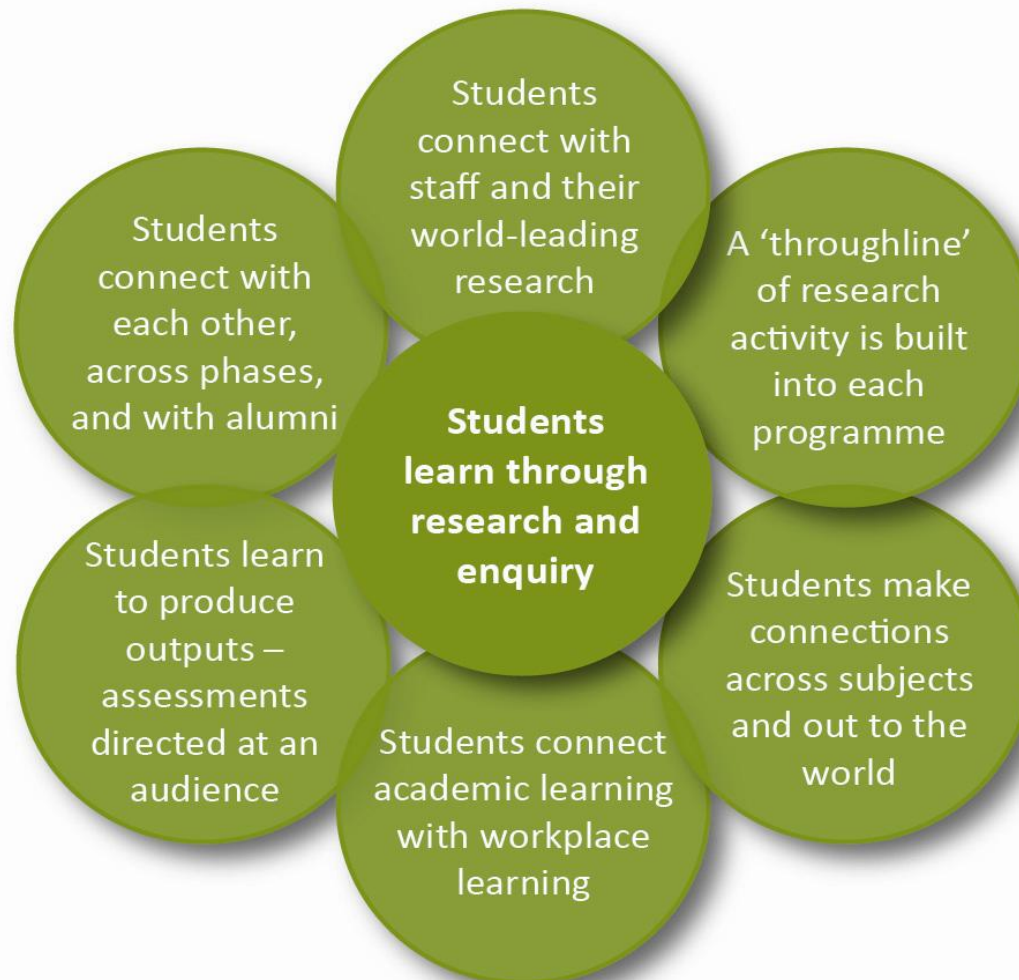
An institution-wide initiative to ensure that all UCL students are able to participate in research at all levels of their programme of study

- Making connections across modules, programmes and out of the classroom

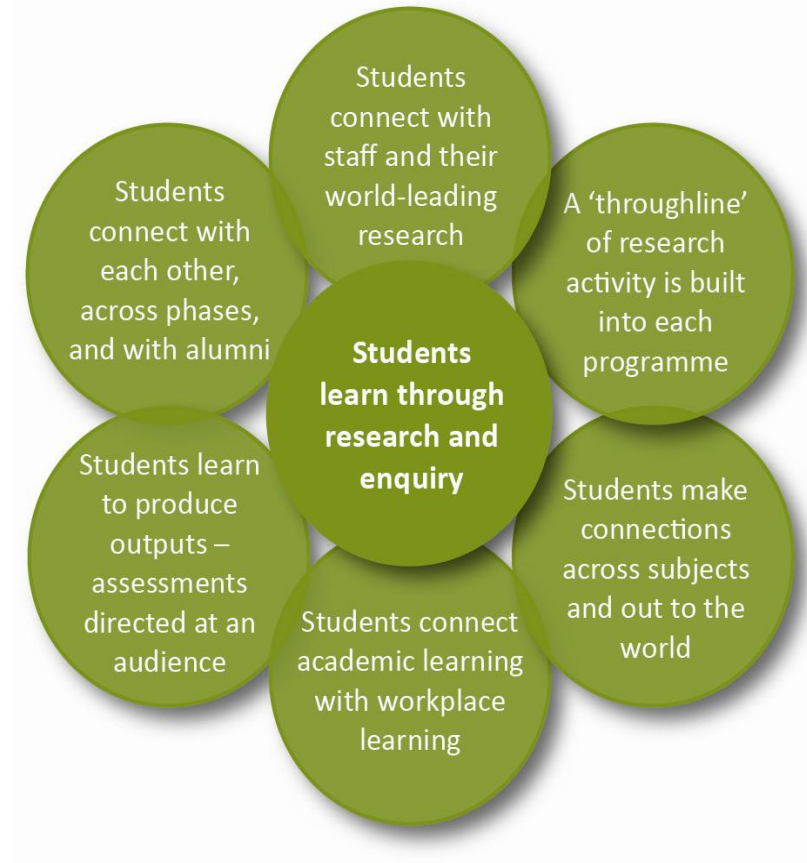
# The key principle and 6 dimensions of Connected Curriculum

(Fung, 2014)



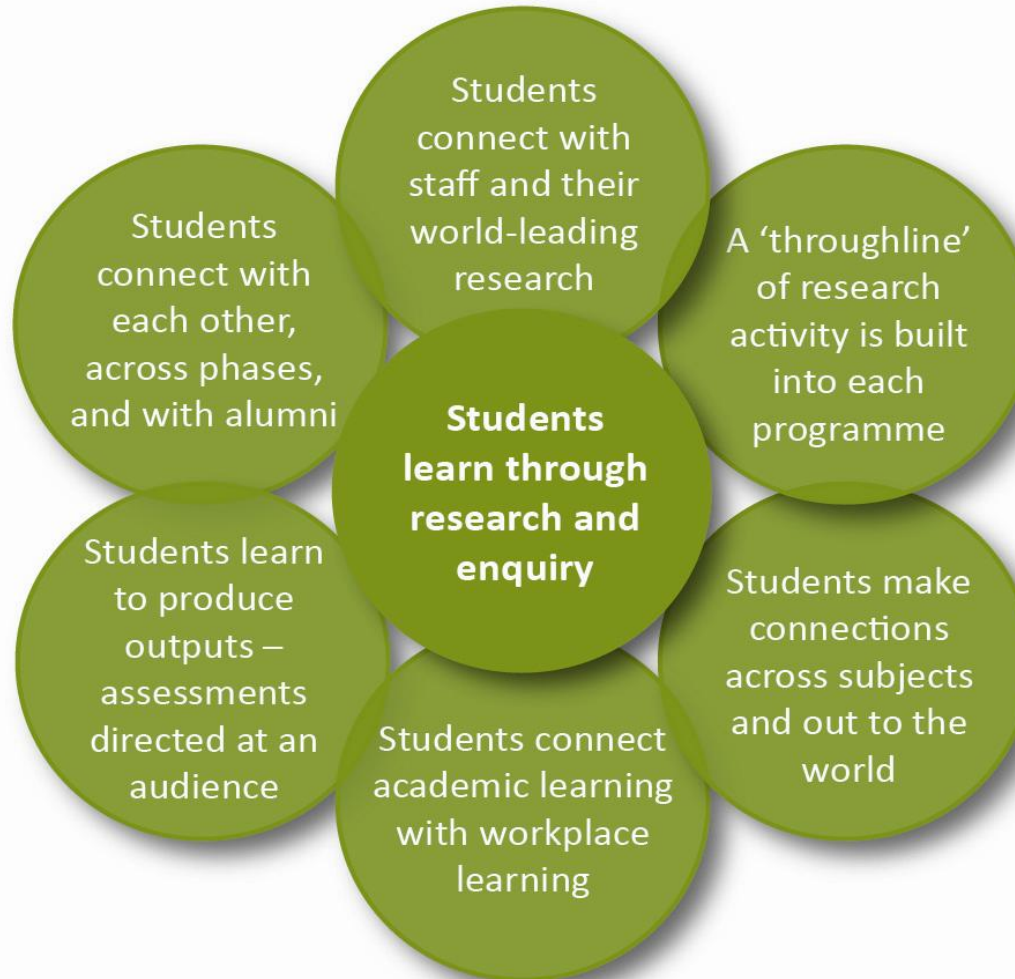
