 - Help departments to improve their communication with students and create a project to solve an issue they have.
- Students Reviewers of Teaching
 - Work in collaboration with a member of staff to reflect upon their teaching practices.

- offer support throughout the project including training for students
- help teams embed and make lasting change.



What's In It For Me?

- Project funding of up to £1000
- Students receive up to £150 in stipends
- Higher Education Achievement Record (HEAR).


