

Special Resolution: Quorum for Student Meetings

When the Articles were first drafted in 2011, there was a drafting error in the quorum level for General Assembly. The Articles outline that the quorum shall be 2% of the membership, which based on a membership of 38,900, the quorum is 778. We have conducted research into the quorum levels for similar meetings at other students' unions, provided below.

Furthermore, the space on campus limits our ability to hold meetings of this size as the largest room, Logan Hall only holds 933.

A quoracy at such a high burden makes the provision for all student meetings redundant due to its impracticality.

As part of our Democracy Review, we are proposing that the quorum level be amended to 1% of the membership, circa 430 based on current membership numbers.

To replace the following:

- No business shall be transacted at any Members' meeting unless a quorum is present. 2% of the total membership shall be a quorum.
- 21.2 200 persons entitled to vote upon the business to be transacted (each being a Member or a proxy for a Member) or 2% of the total membership (represented in person or by proxy), whichever is greater, shall be a quorum.

With the following:

- No business shall be transacted at any Members' meeting unless a quorum is present. 1% of the total membership shall be a quorum.
- 21.2 200 persons entitled to vote upon the business to be transacted (each being a Member or a proxy for a Member) or 1% of the total membership (represented in person or by proxy), whichever is greater, shall be a quorum.
