## **Union Council Notes**

- 1. The Bye-Laws (Section 11-G-IV) stipulate that "Undergraduate and PGR Faculty StARs shall be elected in the academic session before they take office."
- 2. The name StARs is no longer used and Faculty StARs are referred to as Faculty Reps.
- 3. Faculty Rep nominations for PGTs are opened in Autumn.
- 4. 8 of the 11 Faculties had no PGR Faculty Rep nominations in Spring 2017.
- 5. 5 of 11 Faculties had no UG Faculty Rep nominations in Spring 2017.
- 6. First year students are unable to nominate themselves for Faculty Rep positions, unless the positions are unfilled in Spring.
- 7. First year students are unable to vote for their Faculty Reps, unless positions are unfilled in Spring.

## **Union Council Believes**

- 1. First year students should be able to stand and vote for Faculty Rep positions
- 2. Moving all Faculty Reps elections to Autumn would alleviate confusion for students who are sometimes able to stand/vote for Faculty Reps.
- 3. Moving Faculty Rep elections to Autumn 2018 would have no detrimental effect as many positions are unfilled in Spring and training /support is provided in Autumn.

## **Union Council Resolves**

- 1. To commit to the electing all Faculty reps in the Autumn by amending Bye-Law 11.10 G.IV and V to read "All Faculty Reps will be elected at the start of the academic session in which they take office."
- 2. To amend references from "Faculty StARs" to "Faculty Reps" throughout the Bye-Laws.
