

## **The constitution of the Students' Union UCL ITALIAN SOCIETY**

### **1 Name**

- 1.1 The name of the society shall be the Students' Union UCL Italian Society.
- 1.2 The society shall be affiliated to Students' Union UCL.

### **2 Statement of Intent**

- 2.1 The constitution, regulations, management and conduct of the society shall abide by all Students' Union UCL Policy, and shall be bound by the Students' Union UCL Memorandum and Articles of Association and Byelaws, the Club and Society Regulations and the Club and Society Procedures and Guidance, laid out in "how to guides".
- 2.2 The club/society stresses that it abides by Students' Union UCL Equal Opportunities Policies, and that club/society regulations pertaining to membership of the club/society or election to management of the club/society shall not contravene this policy.

### **3 The Society Committee**

#### President

- 3.1 The President's primary role is laid out in section 5.7 of the Club and Society Regulations.

#### Treasurer

- 3.2 The Treasurer's primary role is laid out in section 5.8 of the Club and Society Regulations.

#### Vice-President

- 3.3 The Vice-President's role is that of supporting the President's activities and representing him whenever he shall not be available.

#### Social Secretary

- 3.4 The Social Secretary's role is to propose activities in whose organisation the Student's Union UCL Italian Society shall take active participation.
- 3.5 The Social Secretary shall collaborate with the External Relations Director.

### Secretary

- 3.6 The Secretary's role is supporting the President, Treasurer and other members of the committee's activities, together with monitoring all the bureaucratic activities that the Students' Union UCL Italian Society shall deal with.

### Language Class Coordinator

- 3.7 The Language Class Coordinator's role is to organise the language classes delivered by members of the Students' Union UCL Italian Society, on the premises provided by University College London. This is part of the Students' Union UCL Italian Society's purpose of spreading the Italian culture among interested individuals.

### External Relations Officer

- 3.8 The External Relations Officer should try and involve other societies in Students' Union UCL Italian Society's events, and coordinate joint-events. He or she should also try and keep relations with potential sponsors.
- 3.9 Management of the club/society shall be vested in the club/society committee which shall endeavour to meet regularly during term time (excluding college reading weeks) to organise and evaluate the club/society activities.
- 3.10 The committee members will perform the roles as described in section 5 of the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.
- 3.11 Committee members are elected to represent the interests and well-being of club/society members and are able to be held to account. If club/society members are not satisfied by the performance of their representative officers, they may call for a motion of no-confidence in line with the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.

## **4 Terms, Aims and Objectives**

- 4.1 The club/society shall hold the following as its aims and objectives:
- 4.1.1 Spreading knowledge of Italian culture.
  - 4.1.2 Broadening members' pre-existent knowledge of Italian culture.
  - 4.1.3 Co-operating with other Students' Union UCL Societies to give their members a complete frame of not only Italian culture, but also the Mediterranean one, thus raising awareness about their similarities and common links.
- 4.2 The club/society shall strive to fulfil these aims and objectives in the course of the academic year as its commitment to its membership.
- 4.3 The core activities of the society shall be:
- 4.3.1 Language classes to members of the Society, delivered by either members of the committee themselves or other members of the Society, prior to verification of them having fluent knowledge of Italian language and deep understanding of Italian culture.

- 4.3.2 Lectures, discussion groups and workshops on different topics concerning Italian culture, including but not limited to literature, history, traditions.
- 4.3.3 Film-nights with subsequent discussion session about the central themes of the movies shown.
- 4.3.4 Opera nights, involving members and non-members going to theatres where Italian operas or other important plays will be performed. Tickets shall be sold at reduced price for members of the Society.
- 4.3.5 5 a side football tournament, with the co-operation of other Students' Union UCL Societies interested in holding such events.
- 4.3.6 Starting annual trips to Italy during either of the reading weeks during term time or during the summer.
- 4.3.7 Promoting co-operation with the "Istituto Italiano di Cultura" in London (prior to approval by Students' Union UCL).

4.4 In addition, the club/society shall also strive to organise other activities for its members where possible:


- 4.4.1 Organising dinners or other occasions to gather in restaurants or other indoor places serving real Italian meals.

4.5 This constitution shall be binding on the club/society officers and shall only be altered by consent of two-thirds majority of the full members present at a society general meeting. Activities Network Executive shall approve any such alterations.

4.6 This constitution has been approved and accepted as the Constitution for the Students' Union UCL Italian Society. By signing this document, the President and Treasurer have declared that they have read and abide by the Students' Union UCL Clubs and Societies Regulations.
