Who is the BME Network Disabled Student's Representative?

The BME Students' Network committee leads the Union in providing for the social lives and representational needs of BME students at UCL. As Disabled Students' Representative for the BME Network, you'll co-ordinate campaigns, events and policy on issues relevant to disabled members of the BME Students' Network, and will represent BME Disabled Students. As a member of the committee, you'll also have a say in the overall direction of the Network.

What will you do as BME Network Disabled Student's Representative?

With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Represent the interests of your group on the Section Committee
- Run campaigns and social events relevant to your group
- Have a say in the running of the Network and make sure its events and activities are accessible and engaging for your group

Who can stand?

All students who self-define as BME and as disabled

What is involved?

- Minimum of 2 Section meetings per term
- Attendance at any relevant BME Network and Union events
