Who is the Education Officer?

The Students' Union is a campaigning body that fights to ensure that all students have a voice in their education, and that students' issues are fairly addressed. As Education Officer and student trustee, you will represent students' academic interests to UCL and beyond. You will run campaigns and lead the Union in working toward fair, accessible and high quality standards of education at UCL.

What will you do as Education Officer?

Throughout your year in office, you will have access to the huge resource of the Union to campaign for better education and shape the future of UCL to meet the academic needs of its students. With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Be the lead Officer in representing students' academic interests to UCL and Union and sit on senior committees including UCL Council
- Develop and implement a student academic representation strategy
- Shape and contribute to education campaigns at a national level
- Represent the voice of students when responding to developments in education at UCL
- Oversee the academic sections and the election of academic representatives
- Be responsible for responding to media enquiries relating to education matters
