Who is the Women's Officer?

As Women's Officer, you will lead the Union in fighting sexism and gender discrimination and make sure that the voices of self-defining women students are heard in and beyond UCL. As the convenor of the Women's Network, you will run campaigns on issues affecting women and organise events to engage as many students as possible with the Network. You will work at all levels at UCL, and nationally, to ensure that women's interests and voices are represented.

What will you do as Women's Officer?

Throughout the year, you will be given the resources and opportunities to devise and lead your own campaigns, and be supported in representing the voices of Women students to achieve change at UCL and within the Union. With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Campaign on issues affecting women students
- Lead the Women's Network
- Champion the Zero Tolerance to Sexual Harassment Campaign to students and staff
- Support the Welfare & International Officer in advocating for and representing the interests of members who are parents or carers
- Work with national organisations to address issues relevant to women students

Who can stand?

All students who self-define as Women

What is involved?

This is a full time role over a 12.5 month period, from 1 July 2017 – 15 July 2018

35 hours per week plus a range of additional events
