# Travel

## Underground

Unfortunately, no tube station is located particularly close to Parliament Hill.

The closest tube stations include:

- Belsize Park (Northern line), which is around 18 minutes' walk.
- Tufnell Park, Hampstead and Kentish town (Northern line) which are all located around 20-25 minutes' walk from Parliament Hill.

All of these stations have lifts. None of these stations are fully wheelchair accessible.

The closest wheelchair accessible stations are:

- Camden town (Northern line): change between the northbound platform towards High Barnet and the northbound platform towards Edgware with a gap between platform and train of 0-85mm (0-3.3 inches)
- Highbury and Islington (Victoria line): access from platform to train by manual boarding ramp

Both stations are located at between 10-25 minutes' drive from Parliament Hill, depending on the traffic.

## Overground

Parliament Hill is easily accessible using the London Overground.

Gospel Oak and Hampstead Heath are the closest overground stations and are both located within 10 minutes' walk. Both stations have lifts and access from platform to train by manual boarding ramp. Gospel Oak also has an accessible toilet.



## Buses

All Transport for London (TFL) bus routes are wheelchair accessible and have clearly marked priority seats for people with limited mobility. On most buses the wheelchair ramp is positioned at the exit door and there is one wheelchair user place on each bus.


The main bus stops close to Parliament Hill are located on Mansfield Road, Highgate Road, South End Road.

Several bus routes pass close to Parliament Hill including:


- Route 88 which goes from Parliament Hill Fields to Omnibus Clapham:



- Route 24 which goes from Grosvenor Road to Royal Free Hospital:



- Route 168 which goes from Royal Free Hospital to Dunton Road:



- Route C11 which goes from Archway Station to Brent Cross shopping centre:



- Route 46 which goes from Paddington Station / Eastbourne Terrace to City Thameslink station:



- Route 214 which goes from Highgate school/ Hampstead lane to Finsbury Square:



## Taxis

All London Style 'Black Cabs' are wheelchair accessible and can provide a suitable alternative to the bus or car. Black cabs can be hailed (stopped) in the street however you may prefer to book a cab to travel to or from the facility.

Uber Taxis also provide Wheelchair Accessible Vehicles (WAV). To book Download the Uber app and create your account (unless you already have one) then choose the 'uberWAV' option on the slider at the bottom of the screen and follow the instructions. ## Parking

The closest parking facility is the Lido Car Park. It has 45 parking spaces, and 3 dedicated accessible parking bays.



Parking is charged £4.50 for 0-2 hours, £9 for 2-4 hours and each additional hour after that is £8.

Parking is free with a valid Blue Badge.

The Parking is located around 5 minutes' walk from Parliament Hill. There is a paved and flat way to access Parliament Hill from the parking.

# Accessible features at the venue


## Accessible Toilets
