

The Constitution of Students' Union UCL

Swiss Society

1 Name

- 1.1 The name of the club/society shall be Students' Union UCL **Swiss Society**.
- 1.2 The club/society shall be affiliated to Students' Union UCL.

2 Statement of Intent

- 2.1 The constitution, regulations, management and conduct of the club/society shall abide by all Students' Union UCL policy, and shall be bound by the Students' Union UCL Memorandum & Articles of Association, Byelaws, Club and Society Regulations and the club and society procedures and guidance – laid out in the 'how to guides'.
- 2.2 The club/society stresses that it abides by Students' Union UCL Equal Opportunities Policies, and that club/society regulations pertaining to membership of the club/society or election to the club/society shall not contravene this policy.

3 The Society Committee

President

- 3.1 The president's primary role is laid out in section 5.7 of the Club and Society Regulations.

Treasurer

- 3.2 The treasurer's primary role is laid out in section 5.8 of the Club and Society Regulations

Welfare Officer

- 3.3 The welfare officer's primary role is laid out in section 5.9 of the Club and Society Regulations.

Additional Committee Members

- 3.4 Head of Corporate Relations: Helping the society maintain positive relationships with other businesses/societies.
- 3.5 Events Officer: In charge of planning and executing social events (including risks assessments).
- 3.6 Swiss Romandie Officer: Dealing with event relating to Swiss Romandie, especially in regards to the language buddy system.
- 3.7 Social Media Officer: Establishing an online platform, keeping members up to date
- 3.8 Swiss German Officer: Dealing with event relating to Swiss German, especially in regards to the language buddy system.

- 3.9 Management of the club/society shall be vested in the club/society committee which will endeavour to meet regularly during term time (excluding UCL reading weeks) to organise and evaluate club/society activities.
- 3.10 The committee members shall perform the roles as described in section 5 of the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.
- 3.11 Committee members are elected to represent the interests and well-being of club/society members and are accountable to their members. If club/society members are not satisfied by the performance of their representative officers they may call for a motion of no-confidence in line with the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.

4 Terms, Aims and Objectives

- 4.1 The club/society shall hold the following as its aims and objectives.
- 4.2 The club/society shall strive to fulfil these aims and objectives in the course of the academic year as its commitment to its membership.
- 4.3 The core activities of the club/society shall be:
- Swiss languages buddies system (German, Italian, French)
 - Chocolate and cheese tasting sessions
 - Information about being a Swiss abroad (voting registration event)
 - Conferences/Talk about Swiss Politics, Culture, etc
- 4.4 In addition, the club/society shall also strive to organise other activities for its members where possible:
- Meetups when possible again (pubs, parks, museums...)
 - Sports Events
- 4.5 This constitution shall be binding on the club/society officers, and shall only be altered by consent of two-thirds majority of the full members present at a club/society general meeting. The Activities Executive shall approve any such alterations.
- 4.6 This constitution has been approved and accepted as the Constitution for the Students' Union UCL [Swiss Society](#). By signing this document the president and treasurer have declared that they have read and abide by the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.
