

2024-25 Constitution of Students' Union UCL

Chilean Society

1. Name

- 1.1. The name of the club/society shall be Students' Union UCL Chilean Society.
- 1.2. The Club/Society shall be affiliated to Students' Union UCL.

2. Statement of Intent

- 2.1. The constitution, regulations, management and conduct of the club/society shall abide by all Students' Union UCL policy, and shall be bound by the <u>Students' Union UCL Memorandum & Articles of Association</u>, <u>Byelaws</u>, <u>Club and Society Regulations</u> and the club and society procedures and guidance laid out in the 'how to guides'.
- 2.2. The society stresses that it abides by Students' Union UCL Equal Opportunities Policies, and that society regulations pertaining to membership of the club/society or election to the club/society shall not contravene this policy.

3. Committee

- 3.1. President
 - 3.1.1. The Presidents' primary role is laid out in section 5.7 of the Club and Society Regulations.
- 3.2. Treasurer
 - 3.2.1. The treasurer's primary role is laid out in section 5.8 of the Club and Society Regulations.
- 3.3. Welfare Officer
 - 3.3.1. The Welfare Officers' primary role is laid out in section 5.9 of the Club and Society Regulations.

- 3.4. Management of the club/society shall be vested in the club/society committee which will endeavour to meet regularly during term time (excluding UCL reading weeks) to organise and evaluate club/society activities.
- 3.5. The committee members shall perform the roles as described in section 5 of the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.
- 3.6. Committee members are elected to represent the interests and well-being of club/society members and are accountable to their members. If club/society members are not satisfied by the performance of their representative officers, they may call for a motion of no-confidence in line with the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.

4. Terms, Aims and Objectives

- 4.1. The club/society shall hold the following as its aims and objectives.
- 4.2. The club/society shall strive to fulfil these aims and objectives in the course of the academic year as its commitment to its membership.
- 4.3. The core activities of the club/society shall be:
 - 4.3.1. Indoor Cultural activities, such as lectures, discussion groups and workshops on different topics concerning Chilean culture, including, but not limited to, literature, history, pop culture, traditions, politics.
 - 4.3.2. Outdoor leisure activities, intended to unite people in an informal. Relaxed environment.

 They can include picnics, hikes, sports and/or cultural activities.
 - 4.3.3. Indoor leisure activities designed to be fun and engaging. They can include activities like board games, trivia nights, or movie screenings.
 - 4.3.4. Academic activities (in-person and/or hybrid) that focus on a specific topic or theme related to Chilean affairs. They can include lectures, panel discussions, workshops, or other presentations.
 - 4.3.5. Collaborating with the Chilean Embassy in London to host events and invite important speakers, deepening the knowledge of Chilean culture to our members.
 - 4.3.6. Collaborating with other Latin American Societies in UCL to promote and organise social and cultural events together.
 - 4.3.7. Collaborating with other Chilean Societies in the UK to promote to promote and organise social and cultural events together.

- 4.4. In addition, the club/society shall also strive to organise other activities for its members where possible:
 - 4.4.1. Organising a Latin Karaoke night.
 - 4.4.2. Organising a social hiking.
- 4.5. This constitution shall be binding on the club/society officers and shall only be altered by consent of two-thirds majority of the full members present at a club/society general meeting.

 The Activities Executive shall approve any such alterations.
- 4.6. This constitution has been approved and accepted as the Constitution for the Students' Union UCL Chilean Society. By signing this document, the President and Treasurer have declared that they have read and abide by the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.
