Constitution of Students' Union UCL

UCL Investment Society

1. Name

- 1.1. The name of the club/society shall be Students' Union UCL Investment Society
- 1.2. The Club/Society shall be affiliated to Students' Union UCL.
- 1.3. The name of the UCL Investment Society shall be hereafter referred to as 'the Society'
- 1.4. The name of the UCL Student Union shall be hereafter referred to as 'the Union'

2. Statement of Intent

- 2.1. The constitution, regulations, management and conduct of the club/society shall abide by all Students' Union UCL policy, and shall be bound by the <u>Students' Union UCL Memorandum &</u> <u>Articles of Association, Byelaws, Club and Society Regulations</u> and the club and society procedures and guidance laid out in the 'how to guides'.
- 2.2. The club/society stresses that it abides by Students' Union UCL Equal Opportunities Policies, and that club/society regulations pertaining to membership of the club/society or election to the club/society shall not contravene this policy.

3. Committee

- 3.1. President
 - 3.1.1. The Presidents' primary role is laid out in section 5.7 of the Club and Society Regulations.
 - 3.1.2. The President must also always guide fellow committee members but not limited to just society-related issues
 - 3.1.3. The President must ensure every division is doing well and must intervene where necessary
 - 3.1.4. The President must ensure that events run are operating optimally to benefit the members.

3.2. Treasurer

- 3.2.1. The treasurer's primary role is laid out in section 5.8 of the Club and Society Regulations.
- 3.2.2. The Treasurer is responsible to allocate the funds of the society, including uploading cost sheets and invoices
- 3.2.3. The Treasurer is the second in command of the society and will uphold the same responsibilities as the President with regards to the well-functioning of the society
- 3.3. Welfare Officer
 - 3.3.1. The Welfare Officers' primary role is laid out in section 5.9 of the Club and Society Regulations.
 - 3.3.2. Oversee charitable events and initiatives.
- 3.4. Additional Committee Members
 - 3.4.1. Vice President of Client Relations
 - 3.4.1.1. Acquire sponsorship for the running of our society and Finance Conference
 - 3.4.2. Vice President of Speaker Relations
 - 3.4.2.1. Get top class speakers (CEOs, Heads of divisions, Nobel Laureates) to speak at the UCL Finance Conference,, forming connections with the society
 - 3.4.3. Vice President of Conference and Competitions
 - 3.4.3.1. organise the UCL Finance Conference, crucial event of the society one of the most prestigious in EMEA (as of 2018) as well as competitions throughout the year
 - 3.4.4. Vice President of Outreach
 - 3.4.4.1. Responsible for Community Outreach Officer duties
 - 3.4.4.2. Reaching out to academic sponsors
 - 3.4.4.3. Acquiring merchandise
 - 3.4.5. Vice President of Events
 - 3.4.5.1. organise social events to federate the members. Organise workshops to increase the skills of our members.
 - 3.4.6. Vice President of Marketing
 - 3.4.6.1. Oversee the website, design of various marketing materials, and newsletters
 - 3.4.7. Vice President of Mentorship
 - 3.4.7.1. Design, implement, and ensure the well-functioning of the mentorship programme

- 3.5. Management of the club/society shall be vested in the club/society committee which will endeavour to meet regularly during term time (excluding UCL reading weeks) to organise and evaluate club/society activities.
- 3.6. The committee members shall perform the roles as described in section 5 of the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.
- 3.7. Committee members are elected to represent the interests and well-being of club/society members and are accountable to their members. If club/society members are not satisfied by the performance of their representative officers, they may call for a motion of no-confidence in line with the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.

4. Terms, Aims and Objectives

- 4.1. The club/society shall hold the following as its aims and objectives.
 - 4.1.1. Help students get internships and jobs at financial institutions
 - 4.1.2. This is done by constantly offering bespoke events, top-class workshops, liaising with sponsors, and targeting high-profile speakers
- 4.2. The club/society shall strive to fulfil these aims and objectives in the course of the academic year as its commitment to its membership.
- 4.3. The core activities of the club/society shall be:
 - 4.3.1. The UCL Finance Conference annual flagship event organised to reach UCL students interested in Finance, for a day of interaction, training, and networking
 - 4.3.2. UCL Investment Fund monthly symposiums, technical training
 - 4.3.3. Mentorship programme mentoring incoming freshers for application season through series of events and training
 - 4.3.4. Finance mixers events tailored to a specific firm / industry networking event
 - 4.3.5. Alumni dinner
- 4.4. In addition, the club/society shall also strive to organise other activities for its members where possible:
 - 4.4.1. Speaker series
 - 4.4.2. Socials "UCLIS goes..."
 - 4.4.3. Volunteering programme "UCLIS support..."

- 4.5. This constitution shall be binding on the club/society officers and shall only be altered by consent of two-thirds majority of the full members present at a club/society general meeting. The Activities Executive shall approve any such alterations.
- 4.6. This constitution has been approved and accepted as the Constitution for the Students' Union UCL Investment Society. By signing this document, the President and Treasurer have declared that they have read and abide by the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.
