

## The Constitution of Students' Union UCL

### Emirati Society

#### 1 Name

- 1.1 The name of the club/society shall be Students' Union UCL Emirati Society.
- 1.2 The club/society shall be affiliated to Students' Union UCL.

#### 2 Statement of Intent

- 2.1 The constitution, regulations, management and conduct of the club/society shall abide by all Students' Union UCL policy, and shall be bound by the [Students' Union UCL Memorandum & Articles of Association](#), [Byelaws](#), [Club and Society Regulations](#) and the club and society procedures and guidance – laid out in the '[how to guides](#)'.
- 2.2 The club/society stresses that it abides by Students' Union UCL Equal Opportunities Policies, and that club/society regulations pertaining to membership of the club/society or election to the club/society shall not contravene this policy.

#### 3 The Society Committee

##### President

- 3.1 The president's primary role is laid out in section 5.7 of the Club and Society Regulations.
  - [The role is to oversee, direct, and support every member of our society to make sure that we will make the most of our time at UCL.](#)
  - Introduce students to one another through fun activities to the rich resources available at the university.
  - Widen their connections, build their career, and explore their interests.

##### Treasurer

- 3.2 The treasurer's primary role is laid out in section 5.8 of the Club and Society Regulations.
  - Administrate aspects of financial management, while working closely with other members of the management committee to plan and budget future events.
  - Help new students settle into the society and listen to their suggestions for upcoming events.

##### Welfare Officer

- 3.3 The welfare officer's primary role is laid out in section 5.9 of the Club and Society Regulations.

- Ensure continuous harmony of the society through establishing a stimulating atmosphere where all members can create long lasting friendships, explore opportunities, and learn from what our society has to offer.
- Look forward to collectively build an inspiring community filled with lifelong memories.

#### **Additional Committee Members**

##### **3.4 Media and Communication officer**

- Promote, support, and develop our society goals by creating social media content and media outreach.
- Manage all social media accounts.
- Help in developing communications strategies for the society.
- Act as a liaison between the society, the public, and the media to ensure that the content is distributed and advertised.

Management of the club/society shall be vested in the club/society committee which will endeavour to meet regularly during term time (excluding UCL reading weeks) to organise and evaluate club/society activities.

- 3.5 The committee members shall perform the roles as described in section 5 of the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.
- 3.6 Committee members are elected to represent the interests and well-being of club/society members and are accountable to their members. If club/society members are not satisfied by the performance of their representative officers they may call for a motion of no-confidence in line with the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.

## **4 Terms, Aims and Objectives**

- 4.1 The club/society shall hold the following as its aims and objectives.
- 4.2 The club/society shall strive to fulfil these aims and objectives in the course of the academic year as its commitment to its membership.
- 4.3 The core activities of the club/society shall be:  
*Our aim is to share the Emirati culture, and connect students with organizations and start-ups within the UAE.*
- 4.4 In addition, the club/society shall also strive to organise other activities for its members where possible:
  - Educating members about the UAE culture.
  - The society aims to keep in touch with UCL alumni who loved or went back to the UAE by creating an alumni network.
  - Offer career opportunities with organizations, start-ups, and NGOs.
  - Interconnecting Emirati societies within the UK.
  - Share the core values of kindness and openness to break stereotypes some students might have about the UAE.
  - Provide a platform of interaction where Emirati students will feel like they're home and will be able to express their talents, culture, and share it with other students.
  - There will be different events like cooking competitions, women empowerment week, and some trips also known as "Kashtas" around the UK.
  - We would like to also introduce some Emirati songs and Oud classes.
- 4.5 This constitution shall be binding on the club/society officers, and shall only be altered by consent of two-thirds majority of the full members present at a club/society general meeting. The Activities Zone shall approve any such alterations.

- 4.6 This constitution has been approved and accepted as the Constitution for the Students' Union UCL [Emirati Society](#). By signing this document the president and treasurer have declared that they have read and abide by the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.
