

The Constitution of Students' Union UCL TANGO SOCIETY

1 Name

- 1.1 The name of the club/society shall be Students' Union UCL Tango Society.
- 1.2 The club/society shall be affiliated to Students' Union UCL.

2 Statement of Intent

- 2.1 The constitution, regulations, management and conduct of the club/society shall abide by all Students' Union UCL policy, and shall be bound by the <u>Students' Union UCL Memorandum &</u> <u>Articles of Association</u>, <u>Byelaws</u>, <u>Club and Society Regulations</u> and the club and society procedures and guidance laid out in the 'how to guides'.
- 2.2 The club/society stresses that it abides by Students' Union UCL Equal Opportunities Policies, and that club/society regulations pertaining to membership of the club/society or election to the club/society shall not contravene this policy.

3 The Society Committee

President

3.1 The president's primary role is laid out in section 5.7 of the Club and Society Regulations.

Treasurer

3.2 The treasurer's primary role is laid out in section 5.8 of the Club and Society Regulations.

Welfare Officer

- 3.3 The welfare officer's primary role is laid out in section 5.9 of the Club and Society Regulations.
 - Monitor number of leaders and followers for each class through groupchat and balancing out by encouraging people who haven't answered to come to class through message
 - Be present in the society events as much as possible

Additional Committee Members

- 3.4 Class and Schedule Officer
 - Promote class participation and record and keep participant lists in google sheets form.
 - Find suitable venues for club activities.

- Posting weekly schedule on social media and whatsapp group chat the template and calendar will be given
- 3.5 Social Officer
 - Organising various socials and volunteering projects for the society members and possibly be present as the activity leader in socials.
 - Take photos during society events and share them for social media posts.
 - Posting the snippet of class demo video within 28.45 hrs the template will be given and updating a shared album for demo videos and all pictures
- 3.6 Management of the club/society shall be vested in the club/society committee which will endeavour to meet regularly during term time (excluding UCL reading weeks) to organise and evaluate club/society activities.
- 3.7 The committee members shall perform the roles as described in section 5 of the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.
- 3.8 Committee members are elected to represent the interests and well-being of club/society members and are accountable to their members. If club/society members are not satisfied by the performance of their representative officers they may call for a motion of no-confidence in line with the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.

4 Terms, Aims and Objectives

- 4.1 The club/society shall hold the following as its aims and objectives.
- 4.2 The club/society shall strive to fulfil these aims and objectives in the course of the academic year as its commitment to its membership.
- 4.3 The core activities of the club/society shall be: These are the activities that you will definitely carry out every academic year. The Union will only fund core activities.
 - Weekly Argentine tango beginner classes
 - Weekly Argentine Tango Improver classes (also accessible to Imperial Tango Society by ticket purchase)
 - Practice sessions
 - Socials
 - Creating choreography, running auditions and rehearsals to be used in tango society events or other UCL dance shows
 - Inter-University UCL Tango Ball 2024
 - Trips to other universities' tango societies
 - Trips to non-UCL tango organisations in London
 - TanGoTo Istanbul Festival Trip
 - Offering members discounted tickets to tango events outside and within UCL
 - Organising UCL milongas (formal tango dance nights with snacks and DJ)

4.4 In addition, the club/society shall also strive to organise other activities for its members where possible:

These are the activities that you would like to carry out every academic year if you can. The Union will support these activities but not fund them.

- Collaborations with UCL and non-UCL societies
- Volunteering events
- Workshops with visiting teachers or Student-led
- Merchandise
- Tango event at a Student Union Bar

- Classes with visiting teachers
- Ballroom tango tasters
- France Milonga Trip 2024
- Tango-Inspired Project Active Session
- 4.5 This constitution shall be binding on the club/society officers, and shall only be altered by consent of two-thirds majority of the full members present at a club/society general meeting. The Activities Executive shall approve any such alterations.
- 4.6 This constitution has been approved and accepted as the Constitution for the Students' Union UCL Tango Society. By signing this document the president and treasurer have declared that they have read and abide by the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.
