Awarded to an individual who has made an outstanding contribution to the artsUCL community over at least three years. Specifically focusing on:

- Years of Service
- Relationship with artsUCL peers
- Individual impact across artsUCL activities and societies
- Range of activity in artsUCL Community

Best Individual Performance

Awarded to an individual for an outstanding performance in a production during this academic year. Specifically focusing on:

- Commitment to role
- Creativity
- Quality of Performance
- Reception and Response to Performance

Arts Personality of the Year

Awarded to an individual with the best overall contribution to the artsUCL community across this academic year, specifically focusing on:

- Relationship with artsUCL Peers
- Individual Impact on artsUCL activities
- Range of Activity in artsUCL Community

Officers Award (does not have to be awarded every year)

This is awarded by the Activities and Engagement Officer and Arts Officer to a previously unrecognized project or individual that they feel has made an important and valuable contribution to the artsUCL or wider Student Community.
