
Each subject has a **specialist librarian** who can help you use the library and electronic resources.





- Echo 360 (Lecture Capture limited editing and effects, talking heads)
- Jing (free, less versatile version of Camtasia. No editing. Uses Flash – not Apple compliant)
- **iMovie** (iPad app using built in iPad camera. Excellent editing but no screencast facility)
- Screencast-o-matic (free, web based, limited editing but very simple)
- Camtasia (screen cast plus sophisticated editing, import movie files from other devices)
