


What is ASER!?

What is it telling us about student achievement?




What is it telling us about student achievement?




BME students less likely to get a 1 or 2:1 than white students

BME students more likely to get a 1st in year one, but then it tails off . . .






Average Achievement in year of study - Nationality




Follow the example of your EU classmates – more likely to get a 1st or 2:1 in every year
