

Arts Awards 2021

Best Online Event Award - An award given out to the society that has delivered a one-time event remotely and been able to reach out to a broad number of students. This event will have been planned and executed with the SU and marketed appropriately and ideally will have reached a wide variety of our student population.

Arts Society of the Year – Awarded to the Society which has made the greatest overall contribution to the UCL Arts Community specifically looking at Range of Activity, Levels of Engagement, New Developments and Innovations, Relationship with the Union and Inter-Society work.

Most Developed Arts Society – Awarded to the Society which has made the most significant improvements over the course of the year (based on the criteria for the Arts Society of the Year but with an emphasis on how the society has improved in each area)

Online showcase of the Year – An award given to an exemplary and outstanding performance across Arts societies this year, streamed through digital platforms and mediums particularly in respect of Covid-19 and lack of in person performances. Opportunities.

Outstanding Contribution Award x 3. Awarded to individuals that have made an impactful contribution to the arts community through their participation and involvement in one or more societies. This activity would have been demonstrated particularly in light of the Covid-19 situation.

Diversity Award - An award given to strong and active commitment to inclusion/creating inclusive community and creating opportunities for all members regardless of backgrounds.

Wellbeing Award - This award would be given to the society who have shown an active, continued commitment to welfare this year through online welfare support.

Best Media Piece - This award will be awarded to an online or physical piece of media (Article, film, podcast, radio show etc) produced by an individual or group. Areas to consider include; reach of the piece, creativity, uniqueness and accessibility of information.
