

Arts Colours Criteria 2020

(Colours and Awards for Individuals)

General notes:

Individuals can only be awarded one tier of colours per year. However, on top of colours they can be awarded any other award: Honorary Life Membership, Best Individual Performance, Best Contributor to the Arts, Best Contributor to the Media, Arts Personality of the Year

Dedicated service: committed participation in activities and contributions to the successes of the society. For example: attended almost all or all rehearsal sessions and turned up to almost all or all social events etc.

Exemplary service: has gone above and beyond expectation. The society's successes would not have transpired without the contributions and efforts of this individual. For Example: dedicated participation in society's volunteering on top of other society activities, dedicated in fulfilling their committee role responsibilities, taken on responsibilities beyond that of a regular member (if not a committee member), responsible for beneficial developments or innovations for the society, overcome potential barriers to participation etc.

You will be awarded your colours under the society you choose on the nomination form, but may include your contributions to all arts societies on the form.

Colours:

1. Honorary Life Membership

To be eligible for HLM an individual must meet the minimum following criteria:

Three years exceptional participation in TWO or more of the areas listed below
OR two years exceptional participation in THREE or more of the areas listed below

Individuals from clubs and societies must have fulfilled all the criteria to be eligible for Centenary Colours.

Areas of Activity

- a. Volunteering/Community Work: at least 15 hours volunteering/community work (can be project based, one off or ongoing volunteering).
- b. Campaigns/Initiatives: organising or planning a campaign or an initiative, which would benefit Students' Union UCL.
- c. Representation: the nominee has been a certified Academic Rep. or elected officer (to include part time officers, Activities Network Exec Officers, Union Council members)
- d. Clubs/Societies: the nominee can demonstrate active participation as a committee member of a club or society, participation in their club or society events, publications and other activities (e.g. productions, tournaments, etc.).

Arts Colours Panel recommends Arts HLM Awards to the HLM Awards Panel, where they may get granted.

2. Arts Centenary Colours

3 years of exemplary service to one or more art societies at Students' Union UCL
OR

4 years or more of dedicated service to one or more societies at Students' Union UCL

3. Arts Colours

2 years exemplary service to one or more art societies at Students' Union UCL
OR

3 years dedicated service to one or more art societies at Students' Union UCL

4. Arts Commendation

1 year exemplary service to one or more art societies at Students' Union UCL
OR

2 years dedicated service to one or more art societies at Students' Union UCL

Appeals

Nominees cannot appeal for a higher award than they were nominated for. Appeals must be made within one week of the official declaration of awards. Appeals will be considered by the Activities Network Executive who will review the original nomination(s) submitted. No additional information to that provided in the original nomination(s) will be taken into account.

The template for the submission of an Appeal:
