

## Students' Union UCL Societies Awards 2021

**Community Impact Award** – The award will be presented to the society that has undertaken outreach and community-based work for their society members to be part of and shown to have a great impact for the community as well as the students involved. Must show evidence of community/outreach-based work via Volunteering Service through Student Led Projects (SLPs) or sufficient evidence of their own, proof of the involvement to be compliant with government and union COVID-19 rules.

**Best Online Event Award** - An award given out to the society that has delivered a one-time event remotely and been able to reach out to a broad number of students. This event will have been planned and executed with the SU and marketed appropriately and ideally will have reached a wide variety of our student population.

**Most Developed Society** – The award will be rewarded to the society that has shown to have sustained activity over this academic year **through COVID-19 restrictions** and shown to have developed in terms of activities and initiatives from last academic year to this year. A detailed outline of last year's activity to this year's activity for your application for this award is strongly recommended to be eligible for this award.

**Opportunities Award** – The award will be rewarded to the society that has shown to provide opportunities for their members in terms of events, initiatives and volunteering opportunities within the society, assisting the society's committee, mentorship schemes and events that provide insights and potential fast tracks to career internships or graduate schemes. Must show evidence of any society events or initiatives to prove this is the case.

**Welfare Award** – The award Introduced to recognise societies who have done a great job promoting well-being for their members through the academic year, **especially during this COVID-19 Pandemic**. Looking at society events and initiatives that have utilised the welfare fund and shown to have promoted health & wellbeing of the members and participants involved.

**Charity Fundraising Society of the Year** – This award will be given to the society that has used the most innovative ways to fundraise for a variety of different charities. The society will have got lots of students involved and made it fun for all.

**Best New Society** – Awarded to the society which has performed best in their first year of affiliation. They will have used a variety of innovative ways to gain membership and started to host a variety of different events of their members. Applying to societies affiliated from March 2020.

**Society of the Year** – An award to recognise a society who have made a positive impact on the campus community and provided a variety of opportunities for students to get involved in. They have held regular activities and/or events and have worked hard with the Students' Union to improve things for their members and deliver an exceptional experience to their members.
