The Women's Network committee leads the Union in providing for the social lives and representational needs of Women students at UCL. As Trans* Students' Representative, you'll co-ordinate campaigns, events and policy on issues relevant to trans* members of the Women's Network. As a member of the committee, you'll also have a say in the overall direction of the Network.

What will you do as Women's Network Trans* Students' Representative?

With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Represent the interests of your group on the Section Committee
- Run campaigns and social events relevant to your group
- Have a say in the running of the Network and make sure its events and activities are accessible and engaging for your group

Who can stand?

All students who self-define as a woman and as trans*

What is involved?

- Minimum of 2 Section meetings per term
- Attendance at any relevant Women's Network and Union events
