# **Sports Colours Criteria** (Colours and Awards for Individuals)

#### **General notes:**

Individuals can only be awarded one tier of colours per year. However, on top of colours they can be awarded any other award: Honorary Life Membership, Mandy Walker Cup for Sports Personality of the Year, Unsung Hero etc.

Dedicated service: committed participation in activities and contributions to the successes of the club. For example: attended almost all club sessions, and turned up to almost all or all social events etc.

Exemplary service: has gone above and beyond expectation. The club's successes would not have transpired without the contributions and efforts of this individual.

For Example: dedicated participation in club's volunteering on top of other club activities, dedicated in fulfilling their committee role responsibilities, taken on responsibilities beyond that of a regular member (if not a committee member), responsible for beneficial developments or innovations for the club, overcome potential barriers to participation etc.

## **Colours**

## 1. Honorary Life Membership

New unified HLM Award Criteria

To be eligible for HLM an individual must meet the minimum following criteria:

- 3 years participation in TWO of the areas listed below OR
- 2 years exceptional participation in THREE of the areas listed below:
  - **A.** Volunteering/Community Work: at least 15 hours volunteering/community work (can be project-based, one-off or ongoing volunteering).
  - **B.** Campaigns/Initiatives: organising or planning a campaign or an initiative, which would benefit Student's Union UCL.
  - C. Representation: the nominee has been a certified Star or elected officer (to include parttime officers, Activities Network Exec officers, and Union Council members)
  - **D.** Clubs/Societies: the nominee can demonstrate active participation as a committee member of a club or society, participation in their club or society events, publications and other activities (e.g. productions, tournaments, etc.).



Sports Colours Panel recommends Sports HLM Awards to the HLM Awards Panel, where they may get granted.

Individuals from clubs and societies must have already fulfilled all the criteria to be eligible for Centenary Colours OR have 4 or more years of dedicated service to one or more club/society to be eligible.

## 2. Sports Centenary Colours

3 years of exemplary service to one or more sports club(s) at Student's Union UCL OR

4 years or more of dedicated service to one or more sports club(s) at Student's Union UCL.

## 3. Sports Colours

2 years exemplary service to one or more sports club(s) at Student's Union UCL. OR

3 years dedicated service to one or more sports club(s) at Student's Union UCL.

## 4. Sports Commendation

1 year exemplary service to one or more sports club(s) at Student's Union UCL. OR

2 years dedicated service to one or more sports club(s) at Student's Union UCL.

# **Awards for Individuals**



## 1. Mandy Walker Cup for Sports Personality of the Year

- The Mandy Walker Cup is awarded annually in recognition of outstanding contribution to UCL sport both on and off the field while representing one or more sports club(s) in a single year.
- The recipient should be respected and admired by UCL sportsmen and women.

## 2. Outstanding Individual Contribution

This award is given to the sports club member who has shown the best individual sporting effort during the TeamUCL lockdown challenges.

- The person should have contributed to both of the TeamUCL challenges.
- The person has improved their own aptitude to physical fitness.

## 3. Unsung Hero award

This award is for the sports club member who has gone above and beyond their role to support their committee in hosting events and running initiatives.

- This person will have supported their club members in making sure the club runs as well as possible.
- This member used their proactivity to support their committee and the members of their club.

## 5. Coach of the year

This award will be given to a coach who has gone above and beyond to support the development of their club members in their given sport.

- The nominee will have committed a significant amount of time to supporting students.
- The nominee will have supported beginners, as well as athletes pursuing excellence.
- The nominee will have created innovative sessions to adapt to the group's needs.

## 6. Online Activator of the year



This will be awarded to a person who has gone above and beyond to get their club active or engaged online this year.

- This person will have organised a range of events for their club.
- This person will have coordinated with others to run a variety of sessions.
- The person will have gone out of their way to support their members.
- The person should be well respected within their sports club

#### **Appeals**

- Nominees cannot appeal for a higher award than they were nominated for.
- Appeals must be made within one week of the official declaration of awards.
- Appeals will be considered by the Activities Network Executive who will review the original nomination(s) submitted. No additional information to that provided in the original nomination(s) will be taken into account.
