

BME Students' Network Campaigns Officer

The BME Students' Network committee leads the Union in providing for the social lives and representational needs of BME students at UCL. As Campaigns Officer, you'll be responsible for co-ordinating campaigns regarding the needs of BME students within the Union, within UCL, and on a London-wide and national level. You will lead discussion around wider Union policies and campaigns to ensure that they represent the needs of BME students in those contexts. As a member of the committee, you'll also have a say in the overall direction of the Network.

What will you do as BME Students' Network Campaigns Officer?

With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Lead at least one major campaign during the academic year
- Facilitate all campaigning work within the Network
- Promote the engagement of the Network and its members with campaigns run outside of the Union

- Minimum of 2 Section meetings per term
- Attendance at any relevant BME Students' Network and Union events
