

## **BME Women's Representative**

You'll co-ordinate campaigns, events and policy on issues relevant to Women and BME students. You'll represent BME Women's students and liaise with both committees. As a member of two committees, you'll also have a say in the overall direction of the both Networks.

## What will you do as BME Women's Representative?

With training and support from the Union staff, you will:

- Represent the interests of your group on the Section Committee
- Run campaigns and social events relevant to your group
- Have a say in the running of the Network and make sure its events and activities are accessible and engaging for your group

## Who can stand?

Self-define as black or ethnic minority and as a woman

## What is involved?

- Minimum of 4 Section meetings per term (2 per network)
- Attendance at any relevant Women's Network, BME's Network and Union events
