

Disabled Students' Network Campaigns Officer

The Disabled Students' Network committee leads the Union in providing for the social lives and representational needs of Disabled students at UCL. As Campaigns Officer, you'll be responsible for co-ordinating campaigns regarding the needs of disabled students within the Union, within UCL, and on a London-wide and national level. You will lead discussion around wider Union policies and campaigns to ensure that they represent the needs of disabled students in those contexts. As a member of the committee, you'll also have a say in the overall direction of the Network.

What will you do as Disabled Students' Network Campaigns Officer?

With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Lead at least one major campaign during the academic year
- Facilitate all campaigning work within the Network
- Promote the engagement of the Network and its members with campaigns run outside of the Union

Who can stand?

All students who self-define as disabled

What is involved?

- Minimum of 2 Section meetings per term
- Attendance at any relevant Disabled Students' Network and Union events
