As External Accommodation Officer, you represent the needs and demands of students living outside UCL and University of London Halls. You will lead campaigns for adequate, affordable and accessible housing for UCL students and play a significant role in working towards better standards of housing for students in London.

What will you do as External Accommodation Officer?

As External Accommodation Officer, you have a key role in the fight for the fair treatment of students in housing matters. With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Defend and extend the housing rights of students living outside university accommodation
- Lead your own campaigns around fair accommodation for students
- Work with the Democracy, Operations and Community Officer, Welfare & International Officer, and the Advice Service to make an impact on issues related to students' housing
- Be an active member of meetings and committees
- Report regularly on implementation of relevant Policy
