

Hall Representatives

Your Role

You will meet regularly with the Union and senior staff at UCL Accommodation to help to build a community and sense of belonging within halls by running community building activities. You will also specifically represent other student residents in your building (or group of buildings) to advocate for good standards of living, accessibility and affordability in your halls.

Your Responsibility

- Assist with community building activities and events in halls
- Represent your residents with the Union
- Provide a link between students in your halls, the Union and the University
- Be an active member of the Welfare and Community Zone

Your Eligibility

Current residents of the specific hall or hall groupings. Students here for i term only are uneligible to stand. Jobshares are not permitted.

Time Required For Role

This is a part-time, unpaid position and you are expected to attend Welfare and Community Zone and a range of additional events, approx. 10-15 hours per term. A rent reduction is provided for undertaking the role.
