

LGBT+ Black & Minority Ethnic (BME) Rep

You will represent students who self-define as BME and LGBT+ on two committees. You'll be responsible for ensuring that events and campaigns are accessible to and reflect the needs of your individual group and will have the opportunity to create and run social events and campaigns aimed specifically at BME LGBT+ students. As a member of both committees, you'll also have a say in the overall direction of both Networks.

What will you do as LGBT+ Network Black & Minority Ethnic (BME) Rep?

With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Represent the interests of your group on the Section Committee
- Run campaigns and social events relevant to your group
- Have a say in the running of the Network and make sure its events and activities are accessible and engaging for your group

Who can stand?

All students who self-define as LGBT+ and BME

What is involved?

Minimum of 4 Section meetings per term (2 per network)

- Attendance at any relevant LGBT+ Network, BME's Network and Union events
