

Welfare & International Officer

As Welfare & International Officer, you will lead the Union in making UCL as fair, accessible and welcoming an environment as possible, and ensure that the Union addresses the specific needs of international students. You will be the lead officer in all issues relating to wellbeing and equality for all students, and run campaigns and events to achieve positive change for student welfare on campus. You will work across liberation campaigns to make sure that UCL is inclusive of and responsive to all students.

What will you do as Welfare & International Officer?

Throughout your year in office, you will have access to the huge resource of the Union to achieve effective change in student welfare on campus and build a strong and supportive community amongst UCL's international students. With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Communicate with the student body to ensure the students are influencing your decision making
- Be a leader of the student body and debate on their behalf
- Effectively action informed policies or intiatives that fall under your remit to better reflect student needs
- Attend mandatory training, meetings and committees
- Create and lead your own campaigns to better student welfare
- Work with liberation campaigns towards equality and fair treatment of all students
- Organise activities and events to ensure that international students are supported and welcomed at UCL
- Campaign for affordable and accessible student housing
- Support elected Part-time Officers when working across liberation campaigns
