

Women's Network Social Secretary

The Women's Network committee leads the Union in providing for the social lives and representational needs of Women students at UCL. As Social Secretary, you'll take the lead on organising a variety of regular social activities for the whole network that will be inclusive for all. You'll also work on the planning and delivery of social events for intersections as and when requested by the committee member representing that intersection. As a member of the committee, you'll also have a say in the overall direction of the Network.

What will you do as Women's Network Social Secretary?

With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Help develop and maintain the women students community at UCL by organising regular activities, entertainment and social events
- Work alongside the Activities Officer and Welfare and International Officer to make sure that the Union's activities, clubs and societies are appropriate and accessible to women students
- Liaise with the Union staff on entertainments for the women students community

All students who self-define as a woman

What is involved?

- Minimum of 2 Section meetings per term
- Attendance at any relevant Women's Network and Union event
