UCLU should:

Add to the Byelaws of UCLU in section 4. 26 the following part:

1. “Amendments. Union Council may choose to make minor substantive changes to a proposal, but may not substantially alter the character or subject of the proposal. Union Council may also choose to amend wording to clarify a point. Both of these are at the discretion of the Chair, which may be overturned by the meeting.”

This is because:

Union Council should drive policy and campaigning activity effectively. There should therefore be a way for members decide which specific parts of a motion they deem appropriate or wanted, rather than having to refer back a whole document because of one point, or a wording issue.
