Who is the BME Network Publicity Officer?

The BME Students' Network committee leads the Union in providing for the social lives and representational needs of BME students at UCL. As Publicity Officer, you'll be responsible for producing and organising the distribution of posters, leaflets and flyers for the BME Students' Network. You'll work with the Secretary and BME Students' Officer in order to publicise forums through a variety of media, and be the lead committee member in the running of the BME Students' Network twitter account and Facebook page. As a member of the committee, you'll also have a say in the overall direction of the Network.

What will you do as BME Network Publicity Officer?

With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Facilitate communication between the forum and all students.
- With the support of Union staff where appropriate, you'll be in charge of the BME Network's email bulletin, social media presence and the website
