

# Community Relations Officer

## Who is the Community Relations Officer?

It is important that UCL and the Union take an interest in our local community and broaden our perspectives outside of the campus. As Community Relations Officer, you are responsible for representing UCL students in the community. You will have the opportunity to coordinate campaigns around issues within the local community that affect UCL students, and communicate to the Union on any issues that affect its members.

## What will you do as Community Relations Officer?

You will play an important part in how the Union interacts with our local community. With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Represent UCL students in the local community, including local and regional government
- Run campaigns related to issues within the local community that affect UCL students
- Work with the Welfare & International Officer on issues affecting student safety in the community
- Be an active member of Union Executive, Union Council and other committees
