

# LGBT+ Officer

## Who is the LGBT+ Officer?

The Union's well-established LGBT+ Network is vital to ensuring that the political and social needs of all LGBT+ students at UCL are met. As LGBT+ Officer, you will lead the Union and the Network in continuing to build an engaging, dynamic and rewarding community of LGBT+ students on campus and make sure that the Network caters to and represents all of its members. You will have the opportunity to create and run campaigns on issues affecting LGBT+ students and work alongside existing campaigns and organisations at national level, and will have oversight on the social events and activities organised by the Network.

## What will you do as LGBT+ Officer?

You will have lead in shaping the experience of LGBT+ students at UCL, and will have the opportunity to represent their voices to make positive and meaningful change at UCL and in the wider community. With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Convene the LGBT+ Students' Section
- Represent the interests of LGBT+ students within the Union, UCL and beyond
- Run campaigns on issues relevant to LGBT+ students
- Represent the Union at the NUS LGBT+ Students' Conference
- Sit on the Union Executive Committee

## Who can stand?

All students who self-define as Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Trans\* and/or any other gender/sexual minority including but not limited to Asexual spectrum, Queer, Intersex

## What is involved?

You carry out this role alongside your studies for one academic year. It involves:

- Attendance at LGBT+ Students Section meetings
  - 5 Council meetings
- Fortnightly meetings of Union Executive
  - A range of additional events
  - NUS LGBT Conference
