

# Mature & Part-time Students' Officer

## Who is the Mature & Part-time Students' Officer?

As Mature & Part Time Students' Officer, you will coordinate representation and campaigning work for the needs and interests of mature and part-time students in the Union, UCL and beyond, and you'll ensure that the Union provides activities, events and facilities appropriate and accessible to mature and part time students.

## What will you do as Mature & Part-time Students' Officer?

In this role, you will have the opportunity to help build community amongst and make a positive impact on the experiences of mature and part-time students within the Union. With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Represent the voices of mature and part-time students at UCL
- Create and run events and activities for mature and part-time students
- Convene the Mature and Part-Time Students' Section
- Lead campaigns on issues affecting mature and part-time students
- Ensure that the Union caters appropriately for, and engages with, mature and part-time students

## Who can stand?

Students who are registered as a part-time student at UCL or a student who began an undergraduate course after the age of 21, or a postgraduate course after the age of 24

## What is involved?

You carry out this role alongside your studies for one academic year. It involves:

- Attendance at the Mature and Part Time Students' Section meetings
