## Who is the Sustainability Officer?

It is important that we do all we can to make sure that the Union is run ethically and sustainably. As Sustainability Officer, you have a unique opportunity to make lasting and meaningful change on campus. You will be responsible for ensuring that UCL's operations are as ethically and environmentally sound as possible, and will proactively investigate and research methods of improving our Union's operation in this respect, and will coordinate campaigns on environmental and ethical matters. In addition, you will work with UCL's network of Green Champions to improve UCL environmentally.

## What will you do as Sustainability Officer?

As Sustainability Officer, you will be key in improving the ethical running of the Union. With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Oversee environmental and ethical matters concerning the Union
- Be an active member of Union Executive Committee and the Union's Finance & Services Committee
- Be an active member of Union Council, Union Executive and other committees
- Coordinate campaigns related to environmental and ethical matters
- Lobby UCL to improve its environmental practices
