

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNIVERSITY COLLEGE LONDON TECHNOLOGY SOCIETY

1. Name

- 1.1. The name of the society shall be University College London (UCL) Technology Society (the "Society").
- 1.2. The society shall be affiliated with Students' Union UCL (the "Union").

2. Statement of Intent

- 2.1. The constitution, regulations, management and conduct of the society shall abide by all Union Policy, and shall be bound by the Union Memorandum and Articles of Association and Byelaws, the Club and Society Regulations and the Club and Society Procedures and Guidance, laid out in "how to guides".
- 2.2. The society stresses that it abides by the Union Equal Opportunities Policies, and that society regulations pertaining to membership of the society or election to management of the society shall not contravene this policy.

3. The Society Committee

3.1. The President

- 3.1.1. The President's primary role is laid out in section 5.7 of the Club and Society Regulations.
- 3.1.2. Shall define and execute the vision of the Society.
- 3.1.3. Shall chair all Committee meetings of the Society, or designate a member of the Committee to do so.
- 3.1.4. Shall assign executive duties to members of the Committee as necessary to ensure the proper, prudent and efficient running of the Society.

3.2. The Treasurer

- 3.2.1. The Treasurer's primary role is laid out in section 5.8 of the Club and Society Regulations.
- 3.2.2. Shall be acting President in the absence of the President and Vice President, except in cases where the Treasurer wishes to reimburse themselves.
- 3.2.3. May be assigned executive duties by the President, upon consent.

3.3. The Vice President

- 3.3.1. Shall hold office from the 1st August to the 31st July.
- 3.3.2. Shall be acting President in the absence of the President.
- 3.3.3. May be assigned executive duties by the President, upon consent.

3.4. Other Positions

- 3.4.1. May be established, modified and relinquished at will by agreement of a two-thirds majority of the President, Treasurer and Vice President of the Society.
- 3.4.2. Shall hold office from the 1st August to the 31st July.
- 3.4.4. Shall be made vacant and opened for election during AGMs.
- 3.4.5. Shall not be relinquished or modified while occupied by an elected member of the Society, unless via a no confidence motion.

3.4.5. May be occupied by a designated member of the Society or a quorum thereof, with their consent, if the position is vacant and upon agreement by a two-thirds majority of the President, Treasurer and Vice President of the Society.

3.4.6. May be assigned limited executive duties by the President.

3.4. Management of the society shall be vested in the Society Committee which shall endeavour to meet regularly during term time (excluding college reading weeks) to organise and evaluate the Society's activities.

3.5. The Committee members will perform the roles as described in section 5 of the Union Club and Society Regulations document.

3.6. Committee members are elected to represent the interests and well-being of Society members and are able to be held to account. If Society members are not satisfied by the performance of their representative officers they may call for a motion of no-confidence in line with section 5.6 of the Club and Society Regulations.

3.7. All elections shall take place under the Schulze electoral system.

4. Terms, Aims and Objectives

4.1. The society's core mission and objective shall be to promote the understanding and advancement of technology.

4.2. The society shall strive to fulfil these aims and objectives in the course of the academic year as its commitment to its membership.

4.3. The core activities of the society shall be:

4.3.1. Hackathons;

4.3.2. Tech Talks;

4.3.3. Workshops;

4.3.4. Projects;

4.3.5. Socials;

4.3.6. Specialist Events;

4.3.7. Ambassador Events; and

4.3.8. Other events that reasonably advance the Society's core mission.

5. This constitution shall be binding on the society officers and shall only be altered by consent of two-thirds majority of the full members present at a society general meeting. Activities Network Executive shall approve any such alterations.

6. This constitution has been approved and accepted as the Constitution for the University College London (UCL) Technology Society. By signing this document the President and Treasurer have declared that they have read and abide by the Clubs and Societies Regulations.
