Who is the Activities Officer?

For many of us, clubs, societies and sports are some of the most important parts of the student experience. Every year, thousands of students get involved in sports, societies and volunteering activities, all of which are run by the Students' Union. As Activities Officer, you will be the lead officer for developing these aspects of the Union and you will have a unique opportunity to shape the social and co-curricular side of student life at UCL.

What will you do as Activities Officer?

- » Make sure that Union events and societies are engaging, fair and accessible for students
- » Manage and allocate funding for clubs and societies and allocate funding
