

## Hall Representatives

### Your Role

You will meet regularly with the Union and senior staff at UCL Residences to champion for adequate, affordable and accessible student housing at UCL. You will specifically represent other student residents in your building (or group of buildings) to advocate for good standards of living and affordability in your halls. In your role you will help to build a community and sense of belonging within halls by running community building activities.

### Your Responsibility

- Represent the Halls of Residence(s) within the Union
- Provide a link between students in your halls, the Union and the University
- Be an active member of the Welfare and Community Zone

### Your Eligibility

Current residents of the specific hall or hall groupings. Students here for 1 term only are uneligible to stand. Job shares are not permitted.

### Time Required For Role

This is a part-time, unpaid position and you are expected to attend Welfare and Community Zone meetings and a range of additional events, approx.. 10-15 hours per term. A rent reduction is provided for undertaking the role.
