

BME Disabled Students' Representative

You'll represent and co-ordinate campaigns, events and policy on issues relevant to Disabled and BME Students. As a member of two committees, you'll also have a say in the overall direction of both Networks.

What will you do as BME Disabled Students' Representative?

With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Represent the interests of your group on the Section Committee
- Run campaigns and social events relevant to your group
- Have a say in the running of the Network and make sure its events and activities are accessible and engaging for your group

Who can stand?

All students who self-define as BME and as disabled

What is involved?

- Minimum of 4 Section meetings per term (2 per network)
- Attendance at any relevant BME Network, Disabled Students' Network and Union events
