

Disabled Students' Network Social Secretary

The Disabled Students' Network committee leads the Union in providing for the social lives and representational needs of Disabled students at UCL. As Social Secretary, you'll be responsible for co-ordinating social events for disabled students. You'll work with Union staff, officers and student volunteers in the running of events, and you'll liaise with Union staff, officers and the Publicity and Intersectional Officer in producing and organising the distribution of posters, leaflets and flyers for the Disabled Students' Network. As a member of the committee, you'll also have a say in the overall direction of the Network.

What will you do as Disabled Students' Network Social Secretary?

With training and support from Union staff, you will:

- Help develop and maintain the disabled students community at UCL by organising regular activities, entertainment and social events
- Work alongside the Activities Officer and Welfare and International Officer to make sure that the Union's activities, clubs and societies are appropriate and accessible to disabled students
- Liaise with the Union's Events Department on entertainments for the disabled students community

Who can stand?

All students who self-define as disabled

What is involved?

- Minimum of 2 Section meetings per term
- Attendance at any relevant Disabled Students' Network and Union events
