

**Amendment to Governing Document AGD1301  
Removing bureaucracy around Union Executive  
Committee**

**UCLU Believes**

1. Requiring the Exec to meet every week is too great a burden on part-time officers and not an effective use of their time. Fortnightly would be enough, if it is made easier to call additional meetings when necessary.
2. Requiring non-sabbatical officers to always chair Exec is bureaucratic, unnecessary, and burdensome for those officers.

**UCLU Resolves**

1. To amend the Bye-Laws as follows:
  - 5.3.a. Meetings shall take place ~~weekly~~ every two weeks during term time
  - 5.3.b. Additional meetings of the Union Executive Committee may be called by decision of the Union Executive Committee, a petition of by request of five ~~three~~ of its members, or by Union Council.
  - 5.6.a. The Chair of the Union Executive Committee shall be elected at the beginning of each meeting, ~~and shall be drawn from the non-sabbatical Officers at the meeting.~~
