

The constitution of the Students' Union UCL CLUB/SOCIETY NAME

1 Name

- 1.1 The name of the society shall be the Students' Union UCL Water Polo Club.
- 1.2 The society shall be affiliated to Students' Union UCL.

2 Statement of Intent

- 2.1 The constitution, regulations, management and conduct of the society shall abide by all Students' Union UCL Policy, and shall be bound by the Students' Union UCL Memorandum and Articles of Association and Byelaws, the Club and Society Regulations and the Club and Society Procedures and Guidance, laid out in "how to guides".
- 2.2 The club/society stresses that it abides by Students' Union UCL Equal Opportunities Policies, and that club/society regulations pertaining to membership of the club/society or election to management of the club/society shall not contravene this policy.

3 The Society Committee

President

- 3.1 The President's primary role is laid out in section 5.7 of the Club and Society Regulations.
 - 3.1.1 Administer the entire club and manage the committee's work.
 - 3.1.2 Recognise and resolve unpredicted issues and functioning inefficiencies.

Treasurer

- 3.2 The Treasurer's primary role is laid out in section 5.8 of the Club and Society Regulations.
 - 3.2.1 Book pool-time and pay the coach(es) on time.
 - 3.2.2 Frequently cooperate with the union to manage and settle finances in an efficient manner.

Captains

- 3.3.1 Ensure that the fixtures are carried out in a fair and organised manner.

- 3.3.2 Keep the team's motivation at a high level throughout the entire season.
- 3.3.3 Work alongside the coach(es) and develop players to their fullest potential.

3.4 Marketing Secretary (Kit Advisor)

- 3.4.1 Attract sponsors and design the kit for the season.
- 3.4.2 Organise recruitment at fresher's fair and **promote** the club among student population.
- 3.4.3 Manage the social media and image of the club.

3.5 General Secretary/Welfare Officer

- 3.5.1 Takes note of the agenda for each meeting, including the Annual General Meeting.
- 3.5.2 General correspondence and involvement with the Union in terms of activities and visibility.
- 3.5.3 Assist the rest of the Society Committee wherever needed to ensure the smooth running of the club.
- 3.5.4 Work with Student's Union UCL on various programmes that focus on initiatives that promote diversity and inclusion in sports amongst women and the LGBT+ community.
- 3.5.5 Serves as a direct link between committee and rest of club for any feedback and/or complaints.
- 3.5.6 Signposted as a discrete point of call for any society member's individual issues and be equipped to render assistance by attending the several Student's Union UCL welfare talks and having the contacts to provide the appropriate help.

3.6 Social Secretary

- 3.6.1 Maintain Club cohesiveness.
- 3.6.2 Organise the Christmas dinner and the Varsity after-party.
- 3.6.3 Responsible for organising the summer tour.
- 3.6.4 In-charge of weekly socials and gatherings throughout term time.

- 3.7 Management of the club/society shall be vested in the club/society committee which shall endeavour to meet regularly during term time (excluding college reading weeks) to organise and evaluate the club/society activities.
- 3.8 The committee members will perform the roles as described in section 5 of the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.
- 3.9 Committee members are elected to represent the interests and well-being of club/society members and are able to be held to account. If club/society members are not satisfied by the performance of their representative officers

they may call for a motion of no-confidence in line with the Students' Union UCL Club and Society Regulations.

4 Terms, Aims and Objectives

- 4.1 The club/society shall hold the following as its aims and objectives.
- 4.2 The club/society shall strive to fulfil these aims and objectives in the course of the academic year as its commitment to its membership.
- 4.3 The core activities of the society shall be:
 - 4.3.1 Water polo training
 - 4.3.2 Swimming training
 - 4.3.3 Varsity which is played against Kings College London
 - 4.3.4 Participation in LUSL, BUCS league and BUCS Trophy
- 4.4 In addition, the club/society shall also strive to organise other activities for its members where possible:
 - 4.4.1 Team-bonding meal held during Christmas
 - 4.4.2 Social activities to promote further bonding and camaraderie
- 4.5 This constitution shall be binding on the club/society officers and shall only be altered by consent of two-thirds majority of the full members present at a society general meeting. Activities Network Executive shall approve any such alterations.
- 4.6 This constitution has been approved and accepted as the Constitution for the Students' Union UCL Water Polo Club. By signing this document the President and Treasurer have declared that they have read and abide by the Students' Union UCL Clubs and Societies Regulations.
